• It is old

A new one can save you 20% on your energy bills over the life of the unit, so make this decision wisely.

• Fluctuations in temperature

If you turn on the shower and get scolding hot water followed by ice cold water, then something isn't right. Check the other areas of your home too. Try the kitchen sink, and see if the water changes temperature often. If it does, that means that your heater is on its way out. A newer model wouldn't be doing this. Not only is it bad for your energy bills, but it could also lead to burns on your body. Don't mess around with your health. Get the pros to come take a look.

Long wait times

While nothing is going to work instantly, if you have to wait several minutes for the water to heat up, then it is a sign that you need a new heater. You should get the water that you want quickly, and conveniently. You don't want to be stuck inside without hot water for too long. Get an inspection, and see if it is time to upgrade.
